

# YELLOW RIBBON PROGRAM

The Yellow Ribbon Program pays "for higher out-of-state, private school, or graduate school tuition that the Post-9/11 GI Bill doesn't cover" [1]. Educational institutions opt-in by creating "an agreement with the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA)...to cover tuition and fee expenses that exceed VA's maximum payable amount" [2].

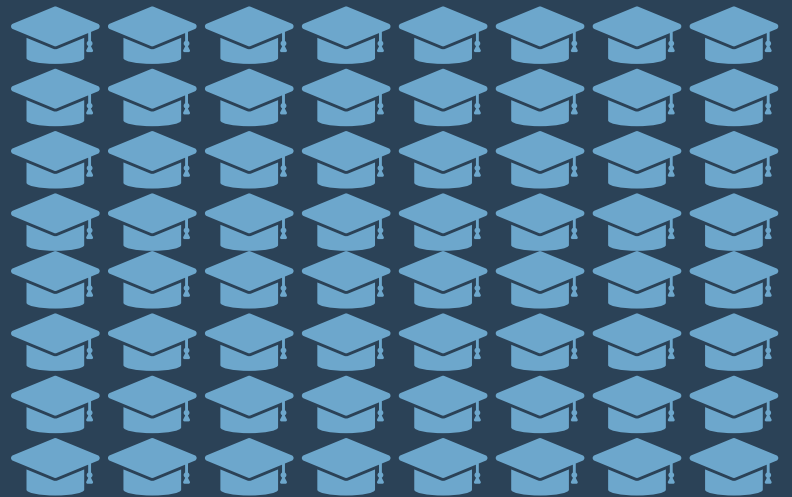
